

Chicago Pride Month is in full swing. While the Chicago Pride Parade and Pride Fest have been postponed until October 3, 2021, do not miss out on celebrating pride month and consider attending one of the events listed below.

This two-day music festival is hosted in Grant Park every June. A portion of the tickets are donated to The Center on Halsted which provides free tickets to LGBTQ+ youth so they can celebrate openly and safely. This year's headliners are Chaka Khan, Tiesto, GRYFFIN, Betty Who and more!

[Navy Pier Pride – June 26th](#)

This daylong event hosted on the Chicago Navy Pier features storytelling, music, dance, and activities Pier-wide with live music in the Beer Garden. Headline performers include the Chicago Gay Men's Chorus and Radio Gaga.

Under normal circumstances, Chicago Pride Month includes close to a hundred events throughout the city.
